Over 1,200 Youth Served

For the first time since the pandemic began, you helped us serve more than 1,200 youth again last year. Last year we partnered with Maury County Schools on the TN All Corps tutoring program to provide after school tutoring from certified teachers during the Club's after school program. Through this program, more than 300 kids received after school tutoring last spring.
