Boys & Girls Club of Pulaski was founded in 1993 to serve the youth of Giles County. In 2017, the Pulaski Club began operating as a unit under Boys & Girls Clubs of Maury County (DBA Boys & Girls Clubs of South Central Tennessee). Since re-opening the Club's doors in December 2017, we have more than doubled the number of youth served - from 50 youth served in 2018, to 120 youth served in 2019. Our average daily attendance has also quadrupled, from 11 youth per day to 45 youth per day. Giles County Executive Director Devon Yurko oversees the Pulaski Club, in addition to working with our Pulaski Advisory Council to raise funds and provide opportunities for kids in Giles County.
